BREAK THE PATTERN

The **Dusk Blend** grid from AKDO is a lively mosaic of glass and stone tiles. **OPPOSITE** (clockwise from top left): A ceramic tile glittering with crushed glass is part of Jeffrey Court's **Facets** collection; the **Xilo** tile is brown from Fox Marble; porcelain painted with a stylized wood grain; a new variation on glass mosaics, **Muracans**; are a dynamic pattern of long rectangles from Daltile; the marble **Bizerte Border** from Tile Fantastic is hand set; Pietra Fina's **Green Tourmaline** granite is named after the gemstone.
